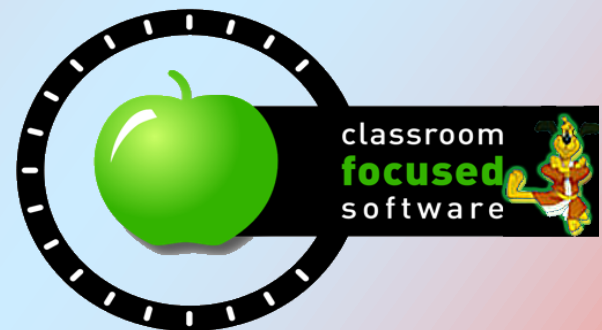
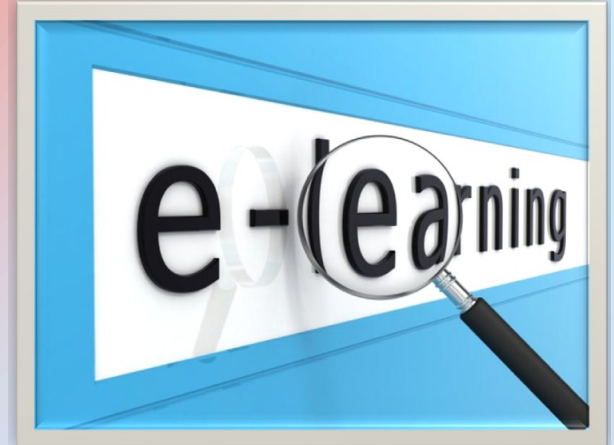
2. BRAIN POWER LEARNING SUITE
